

Attaching Standards

Students, in their Rationales, must identify the standards and indicators tied into each assignment. Students will select from 'specified' standards as is stated in the process below.

In addition, students may elect to use the National Teaching Standards or Content Specific Standards that relate to their specialty, i.e. ISTE National Educational Standards (NET), as well as their own state's standards for professionals or content areas.

- 1) Click the **Standards** button from the **Add** toolbar located at the bottom of the right frame.







1. To use ISTE NETS standards, click the **Standards** button from the **Add** toolbar and select the **View US National Standards** link.

2. Scroll down and click the **USA: ISTE: National Educational Technology Standards (NETS) for All** link.

5. Click the **View Selections** button.
6. If there are no other standards that apply, click the **Save and Return** button. If you would like to add more standards click the **Add More Standards** button.
