
To assess the academic achievement of undergraduate business students at the Colangelo College of Business, Grand Canyon uses the Undergraduate Business Field Test developed by Peregrine Academic Services. This test measures student achievement in 17 specific functional areas, and is administered to all business students during their final capstone course. The results are benchmarked against other schools that administer the same test.

Following are the results for traditional campus students at GCU for the 2016 Spring semester, compared to the aggregate pool of traditional campus students at all universities administering the Peregrine Field Test. CCOB traditional students excelled in all subject areas, and exceeded the total score of the aggregate by 17.1%.

Beginning in Spring, 2016, CCOB also began to assess online students using the Peregrine Business Field Test. Following are the results for CCOB online students for the 2016 Spring semester, compared to the aggregate pool of online students at all universities administering the Peregrine Field Test. CCOB online students excelled in all subject areas, and exceeded the total score of the aggregate by 8.7%.
