What are the Benefits of Being an Out-of-State PLLS Participant?

**GRAND CANYON STATE UNIVERSITY GRANT.\*** PLLS high school students (grades 9-12) who are accepted to attend Grand Canyon University will receive a \$250 GCU grant. The grant is divided into \$125 for the fall and spring semesters as long as the student maintains the minimum GPA requirements.

**SCHOLARSHIP FOR STAFF.** Exclusive **10%** *scholarship* for PLLS faculty, staff and governing board members\*\* on tuition for undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

**CONTINUING EDUCATION/SINGLE COURSE SCHOLARSHIP.** PLLS participants will have access to a **10% scholarship** for their faculty, staff and governing board members\*\*, providing savings for non-degree single courses and continuing teacher education courses.

**SCHOLARSHIP FOR SPOUSES.** Exclusive **5% scholarship** for spouses of PLLS participant faculty, staff and governing board members\*\*, providing savings toward tuition and fees for online undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

**SCHOLARSHIP FOR PARENTS.** Exclusive **5% scholarship** for PLLS parents on tuition for undergraduate or graduate degree programs through the College of Education or a doctoral degree related to the field of education.

**COHORTS.** PLLS participants may request that cohorts be developed for continuing education, individual courses and/or degree programs online or at an approved PLLS site or regionally approved GCU site.

**DUAL ENROLLMENT.** PLLS participants will have access to a catalog of online dual enrollment courses for their high school students, offering them an opportunity to reduce the time to complete a bachelor's degree from four years to three. **This could reduce college costs by up to 25%.** 

**TODAYSLEARN.** PLLS participants will receive access to GCU's TodaysLearn services. Available TodaysLearn opportunities include: Speakers Bureau (motivational speaking and lectures), Professional Development (instruction based on specific subject matter and customized to address specific needs), and Coaching, Mentoring and Consultation (individualized assistance in areas requested).

**ONLINE JOB BOARD.** PLLS participants have access to the GCU Online Job Board to post employment opportunities and search for applicants.

**EVENT DISCOUNTS.** PLLS participants will receive priority communication about events on GCU's campus, including discounted ticket opportunities.

This award cannot be combined with the CCSC Scholarship. \*\*Benefits available to governing board members would be subject to district and school policies. GCU scholarships may be combined up to the following limits: Chancellor/President Award recipients in campus housing – up to \$16,500, all other scholarship recipients in campus housing – up to \$14,000, all scholarship recipients living off campus – up to \$11,500, micro-scholarships, generated through organizations like raise.me, may not be combined with any other form of GCU-funded institutional aid or scholarships may replace GCU institutional aid – up to \$6,000 per academic year.
