## Christian Studies Specific Databases

### ATLA Religion and ATLA Serials

Includes academic articles, essays and book reviews related to all major religious faiths and denominations that are offered by the American Theological Library Association's collection of major religion and theology journals. Includes 150 full-text journals selected by leading religion scholars in the United States.

### JSTOR Arts and Sciences III Collection

Includes full-text back issues of 141 journals in the fields of languages and literature, music, film studies, folklore, performing arts, religion, and the history and study of art and architecture.

### ProQuest Religion

Provides access to over 150 journals, mostly in full-text on biblical, religious, and theological studies. Primary faiths represented include Christianity, Islam, Judaism, and Buddhism.

### Religion & Philosophy Collection

Provides access to over 300 full-text journals that cover topics such as world religions, major denominations, biblical studies, religious history, epistemology, political philosophy, philosophy of language, moral philosophy, and the history of philosophy.
