Business Specific Databases

ABI/INFORM Complete

Includes ABI/INFORM Dateline, ABI/INFORM Global, ABI/INFORM Trade & Industry, ABI/INFORM Archive. Contains over 2,900 full-text titles covering business and economic conditions, corporate strategies, management techniques, as well as competitive and product information.

Books24x7 BusinessPro

BusinessPro, a collection of electronic books from Books24x7, provides fully searchable access to thousands of business titles from leading publishers and authors, including Harvard Business Press, AMACOM, ASTD Press, Oxford University Press, Ken Blanchard, Ram Charan, Bill George, Marshal Goldsmith, Renee Mauborgne, and Dave Ulrich.

Business Source Complete

Includes over 1,800 full-text peer-reviewed journals, plus over 1,700 trade journals and business magazines. Also, includes ebooks and additional full-text, non-journal content, such as financial data, monographs, major reference works, book digests, conference proceedings, case studies, investment research reports, industry reports, market research reports, country reports, company profiles, SWOT analyses and more.

Education Leadership Specific Databases

Education Research Complete

Offers access to over 1,300 full text journals and over 550 books and monographs, and conference papers focusing on all levels of education and all educational specialties, such as multilingual education, health education, and testing.

Emerald Management

Provides access to over 100 journals focusing on business, leadership, and management.

ERIC

Provides access to more than 1.3 million bibliographic records of journal articles and other education-related materials with links to full text when available. ERIC is also accessible through the [Government Site](#) and [Wilson](#) database interfaces.

ProQuest Education Journals

More than 660 of the titles in this database are in full text. Subject coverage includes hundreds of topics such as primary, secondary, and higher education, special education, home schooling, and adult education. Great resource for K-12 professional development and continuing education.

Psychology Specific Databases

ProQuest Psychology Journals

Provides access to over 540 titles in full text, including dissertations that represent a range of psychology disciplines including behavioral, clinical, cognitive, developmental, experimental, industrial, personality, physiological, psychobiology, psychometrics and social psychology.

PsycARTICLES

Contains approximately 150,000 full-text, peer-reviewed articles from over 70 journals published by the American Psychological Association (APA) in general psychology as well as specialized, applied, clinical and theoretical research.

PsycBOOKS

A full-text database of books and chapters in the American Psychological Association's array of quality electronic databases. There are 2,059 scholarly books and 31,750 chapters. Exclusive electronic release of the APA/Oxford University Press Encyclopedia of Psychology including more than 1,500 authored entries.

PsycINFO

American Psychological Association's renowned resource for abstracts of scholarly journal articles, book chapters, books, and dissertations. PsycINFO is the largest resource devoted to peer-reviewed literature in behavioral science and mental health. It contains approximately 3 million citations and summaries dating as far back as the 1600s. Journal coverage, which spans from the 1800s to present, includes international material selected from approximately 2,400 periodicals in dozens of languages.
