Find Your Purpose

Science Specific Databases

BioMed Central

BioMed Central is an independent publishing house committed to providing immediate open access to peer-reviewed biomedical research. Includes 205 full-text journal titles.

CINAHL Plus with Full Text (Cumulative Index of Nursing & Allied Health Literature)

The world's most comprehensive nursing & allied health database. Full-text is available for over 770 journal titles and provides indexing for over 4,500 journal titles. Subjects covered include, nursing, biomedicine, alternative/complementary medicine, consumer health and 17 allied health disciplines.

ProQuest Biology Journals

Includes more than 390 titles available in full text covering a wide range of biology-related topics such as biological chemistry, biophysics, botany, cytology and histology, environmental studies, microbiology, microscopy, and zoology. Journals contain some of the most popular information resources for users in academic, government, and public research environments.

ProQuest Psychology Journals

Provides access to over 540 titles in full text, including dissertations that represent a range of psychology disciplines including behavioral, clinical, cognitive, developmental, experimental, industrial, personality, physiological, psychobiology, psychometrics and social psychology.

ProQuest Science Journals

More than 1,280 titles available in full text in the applied and general sciences, covering hundreds of topics relating to all major fields of study, including physics, engineering, astronomy, biology, earth science, chemistry, and more. Access to all the charts, diagrams, graphs, tables, photos, and other graphical elements so vital to scientific and technical literature.

PsycARTICLES

Contains approximately 150,000 full-text, peer-reviewed articles from over 70 journals published by the American Psychological Association (APA) in general psychology as well as specialized, applied, clinical and theoretical research.

PubMed

PubMed comprises more than 20 million citations for biomedical literature from MEDLINE, life science journals, and online books. Citations may include links to full-text content from PubMed Central and publisher web sites.

ScienceDirect College Edition

Provides access to a journal collection of over 2,000 titles. Major subject areas are: applied sciences, biomedical sciences; economics, business, law, and finance; engineering and material sciences; life sciences; mathematics and computer science; medicine; nursing; physical and environmental sciences; psychology; and social sciences.
