Find Your Purpose

Social Sciences Specific Databases

Dissertations & Theses: The Humanities and Social Sciences Collection

Provides access to over 1 million citations from architecture, biblical studies, education, and more.

JSTOR Arts and Sciences III Collection

Includes full-text back issues of 141 journals in the fields of languages and literature, music, film studies, folklore, performing arts, religion, and the history and study of art and architecture.

LexisNexis

Provides access to over 10,000 news, business, and legal sources. News coverage includes deep backfiles and up-to-the-minute stories in national and regional newspapers, wire services, broadcast transcripts, international news, and non-English language sources. Company dossier provides access to detailed company information and financial performance measures or identify and compare companies matching specific criteria.

ProQuest Criminal Justice

Over 400 publications, with many in full text, including scholarly journals, trade publications, reports, news, and crime statistics, providing information geared to those interested in careers in criminal justice, law enforcement, corrections, drug enforcement, rehabilitation, family law, and industrial security.

ProQuest Education Journals

More than 660 of the titles in this database are in full text. Subject coverage includes hundreds of topics such as primary, secondary, and higher education, special education, home schooling, and adult education. Great resource for K-12 professional development and continuing education.

ProQuest Military Collection

More than 430 periodicals available in full-text covering topics across all government and military branches, including international relations, political science, criminology, defense, aeronautics and space flight, communications, civil engineering, and more. Notable titles include *Joint Force Quarterly: JFQ*, *Military Intelligence Professional Bulletin*, *RUSI Journal: Royal United Services Institute for Defense Studies*, *WashingtonMonthly*.

ProQuest Psychology Journals

Provides access to over 540 titles in full text, including dissertations that represent a range of psychology disciplines including behavioral, clinical, cognitive, developmental, experimental, industrial, personality, physiological, psychobiology, psychometrics and social psychology.

ProQuest Social Science Journals

More than 400 scientific journal titles in fields such as anthropology, communications, criminology, cultural studies, economics, geography, political science, psychology, and sociology. Notable titles include *Journal of Family Issues*, *American Demographics*, *The Public Interest*, and *Spectrum*.

PsycARTICLES

Contains approximately 150,000 full-text, peer-reviewed articles from over 70 journals published by the American Psychological Association (APA) in general psychology as well as specialized, applied, clinical and theoretical research.

PsycBOOKS

A full-text database of books and chapters in the American Psychological Association's array of quality electronic databases. There are 2,059 scholarly books and 31,750 chapters. Exclusive electronic release of the APA/Oxford University Press Encyclopedia of Psychology including more than 1,500 authored entries.
