

Grand Canyon University launches leadership doctorate for teachers

Grand Canyon University is launching a doctoral degree in organizational leadership for teaching professionals.

Beginning in June, a group of 52 teachers will take part in the first program. The group includes 26 teachers from a community in Pennsylvania who will go through the two-year online and on-site program together.

The Phoenix-based university's program is a collaboration of GCU's College of Education with the Ken Blanchard College of Business, promoting leadership skills within an ethical framework.

"The Ed.D. program offers students a rare opportunity to evolve leadership expertise in ways that will positively impact all stakeholders within an organization, including students, teachers, employees, communities and the world," said Cheri St. Arnauld, interim dean of GCU's College of Education.
