What are the Benefits of Being an Arizona CEP Participant?

GRAND CANYON STATE UNIVERSITY GRANT.* CEP high school students (grades 9-12) who are accepted to attend Grand Canyon University will receive a \$1,000 GCU grant. The grant is divided into \$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester as long as the student maintains the minimum GPA requirements.

DEGREE SCHOLARSHIP FOR STAFF. Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CEP faculty, staff and governing board members** on tuition for undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

CONTINUING EDUCATION/SINGLE COURSE SCHOLARSHIP. Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CEP faculty, staff and governing board members** on individual courses from GCU's degree programs, along with a portfolio of six-week online continuing education classes.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR SPOUSES. Exclusive **5% scholarship** for spouses of CEP participant faculty, staff and governing board members**, providing savings toward tuition and fees for online undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR PARENTS. Exclusive **5% scholarship** for CEP parents on tuition for undergraduate or graduate degree programs through the GCU College of Education or a doctoral degree related to the field of education.

COHORTS. CEP participants may request that cohorts be developed for continuing education and/or degree programs on GCU's campus, online or at an approved CEP site or regionally approved GCU site.

DUAL ENROLLMENT. CEP participant schools will have access to dual enrollment courses for their high school students, offering them an opportunity to reduce the time to complete a bachelor's degree from four years to three. **This could reduce college costs by up to 25%.**

GRANT OPPORTUNITIES. CEP participants will be invited to apply for Strategic Educational Alliances grant opportunities, if available.

TODAYSLEARN. CEP participant schools will have access to GCU's TodaysLearn services. Available TodaysLearn opportunities include: Speakers Bureau (motivational speaking and lectures), Professional Development (instruction based on specific subject matter and customized to address specific needs) and Coaching, Mentoring and Consultation (individualized assistance in areas requested).

LOPES LEAP TO TEACH. CEP participants will be invited to recruiting events on campus to meet GCU College of Education students.

STUDENT TEACHING/PRACTICUM PRIORITY PLACEMENT. CEP participants requesting student teaching/practicum placements of GCU teacher candidates receive priority.

ONLINE JOB BOARD. CEP participants have access to the GCU Online Job Board to post employment opportunities and search for applicants.

EVENT DISCOUNTS. CEP participants receive priority communication about events on GCU's campus. CEP faculty, staff and families will receive discounts for GCU academic and athletic camps along with other events sponsored by Strategic Educational Alliances.

GCU FACILITIES. CEP participant schools will receive priority access to GCU facilities, subject to availability. If there is a charge for any facility use, CEP participants will receive a significant discount.

GET THE REAL COLLEGE EXPERIENCE. Discover GCU provides an opportunity for high school juniors and seniors to experience GCU campus life and stay overnight in a residence hall with other prospective GCU students. Additionally, GCU staff members are available to visit your campus to share information about college and career readiness.
