[^] Scholarships may be awarded based on incomplete transcripts. At the time in which final, official transcripts are received, GCU reserves the right to rescind or modify the scholarship if it is determined that eligibility was not achieved. To be eligible, you must meet scholarship requirements. GCU reserves the right to decline scholarship awards for any reason. If you do not meet the minimum renewal criteria, your scholarship will be forfeited. GCU reserves the right to change scholarship awards at any time without notice.

GCU scholarships may be combined up to the following limits:

- i. Chancellor/President Award recipients in campus housing – up to \$16,500
- ii. All other scholarship recipients in campus housing – up to \$14,000
- iii. All scholarship recipients living off campus – up to \$11,500
- iv. Micro-scholarships, generated through organizations like raise.me, may not be combined with any other form of GCU-funded institutional aid or scholarships. Micro-scholarships may replace GCU institutional aid – up to \$6,000 per academic year.

* Priority Registration Grant: The amount of this award ranges from \$250 to \$750 annually, based on the number of available awards at the time of registration. This award is renewable annually for the fall and spring semesters only, as long as you maintain the minimum GCU GPA required. All requirements for registration must be met to receive this grant. Requirements for registration may vary by program.

** CSTEP Grant: This award is for students studying in the computer science, information technology or engineering programs at GCU. It is worth \$1,000 annually, and is renewable for the fall and spring semesters only, as long as you maintain the minimum GCU GPA required. You must stay enrolled in a computer science, information technology or engineering program at GCU. There are a limited number of awards available, which are distributed by order of registration.

*** Grand Canyon State University Grant (in-state and out-of-state): This award is renewable annually for the fall and spring semesters only, as long as you maintain the minimum GCU GPA required. This award cannot be combined with the CCSC Scholarship.

++ CCSC Scholarship: This award is for students attending any private high school in any state that participates in GCU's CCSC program. This award is \$5,000 annually for on-campus residents and \$2,500 annually for off-campus residents. This award is renewable for the fall and spring semesters only, as long as you maintain the minimum GCU GPA required, attend the campus worship service of your choice weekly and meet the 20-hour community service requirement each semester.

◇ Students who have less than 24 attempted college credits must use their high school GPA to qualify for academic scholarships. Students who have 24 or more attempted college credits must use their cumulative college GPA to qualify for academic scholarships

+ Students must complete at least 60 transferable credits at an MCCC school.
