What are the Benefits of Being an Arizona CCSC Participant?

EXCLUSIVE CCSC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS. Students graduating from a Grand Canyon University (GCU) CCSC participant high school can receive a \$5,000 (for those living on campus) or \$2,500 (for those living off campus) CCSC scholarship at GCU per year for each year of attendance at a CCSC participant high school (students must also meet the eligibility requirements). This could save students up to \$20,000 on college tuition over the course of four years.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR STAFF. Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CCSC faculty and staff on tuition for undergraduate, graduate or doctoral programs at GCU.*

CONTINUING EDUCATION/SINGLE COURSE SCHOLARSHIP. Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CCSC staff and parents on individual courses from GCU's degree programs, along with a portfolio of six-week online continuing education classes.*

SCHOLARSHIP FOR SPOUSES. Exclusive **5% scholarship** for spouses of CCSC participant staff, providing savings toward tuition and fees for online undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.*

SCHOLARSHIP FOR PARENTS. Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CCSC parents on tuition for undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.*

GRANT OPPORTUNITIES. CCSC participants will be invited to apply for Strategic Educational Alliances grant opportunities, if available.

COHORTS. CCSC participants may request that cohorts be developed for continuing education and/or degree programs on GCU's campus, online or at an approved CCSC site or regionally approved GCU site.

DUAL ENROLLMENT. CCSC participants receive access to a catalog of dual enrollment courses for their high school students, offering them an opportunity to reduce the time to complete a bachelor's degree from four years to three. **This could reduce college costs by up to 25%.**

TODAYSLEARN. CCSC participants will receive access to GCU's Today'sLearn services. Available Today'sLearn opportunities include: Speakers Bureau (motivational speaking and lectures), Professional Development (instruction based on specific subject matter and customized to address specific needs), and Coaching, Mentoring and Consultation (individualized assistance in areas requested).

LOPES LEAP TO TEACH. CCSC participants will be invited to recruiting events on campus to meet GCU College of Education students.

STUDENT TEACHING/PRACTICUM PRIORITY PLACEMENT. CCSC participants requesting student teaching/practicum placements of GCU teacher candidates receive priority.

ONLINE JOB BOARD. CCSC participants have access to the GCU Online Job Board to post employment opportunities and search for applicants.

EVENT DISCOUNTS. CCSC participants receive priority communication about events on GCU's campus. CCSC faculty, staff and families will receive discounts for GCU academic and athletic camps along with our events sponsored by Strategic Educational Alliances.

GCU FACILITIES. CCSC participants receive priority access to GCU facilities, subject to availability. If there is a charge for any facility use, CCSC participants will receive a significant discount.

EVENTS/OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDENTS. GCU offers a number of opportunities throughout the school year for your students to experience our vibrant campus life. Additionally, GCU staff members are available to visit your campus to share information about college and career readiness.
