## **Child Support Paid**

Please submit the documentation as soon as possible but no later than 120 days after your last day of enrollment, or by September 2016, whichever occurs first. No funds will be disbursed until the verification process is completed. Failure to complete the verification process by the deadline will result in your ineligibility for Title IV funds for the award year. The law states we have the right to ask you for this information before awarding any federal aid. If there are differences between the information supplied on your federal application and your financial documents, we will need to correct this information. We must review the required information under the financial aid program rules (34 CFR, Part 668).

The Department of Education has requested that the institution verify certain items for a student selected for this review. All of the verification items are listed on this Worksheet and must be verified to determine Title IV eligibility.
