What are the Benefits of Being a CCSC Participant?

EXCLUSIVE CCSC SCHOLARSHIP FOR STUDENTS.* Students graduating from a Grand Canyon University CCSC participant high school can receive a \$5,000 (for those living on campus) or \$2,500 (for those living off campus) CCSC scholarship at GCU per year for each year of attendance at a CCSC participant high school (students must also meet the eligibility requirements). This could save students up to \$20,000 on college tuition over the course of four years.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR STAFF.** Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CCSC faculty, staff and governing board members*** on tuition for online, undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

CONTINUING EDUCATION/SINGLE COURSE SCHOLARSHIP.** CCSC participants will have access to a **10% scholarship** for their faculty, staff and governing board members***, providing savings for non-degree single courses and continuing teacher education courses.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR SPOUSES.** Exclusive **5% scholarship** for spouses of CCSC participant faculty, staff and governing board members,*** providing savings toward tuition and fees for online, undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR PARENTS.** Exclusive **10% scholarship** for CCSC parents on tuition for online, undergraduate, graduate or doctoral degree programs at GCU.

LOPES LEAP TO TEACH. Arizona CCSC participants will be invited to recruiting events on campus to meet GCU College of Education students.

DUAL ENROLLMENT. Dual enrollment is available online for out of state high school students and either online or at their high school for Arizona students, offering them an opportunity to reduce the time to complete a bachelor's degree from four years to three. **This could reduce college costs by up to 25%.**

TODAYSLEARN. CCSC participants will receive access to GCU's Today'sLearn services. Available Today'sLearn opportunities include: Speakers Bureau (motivational speaking and lectures), Professional Development (instruction based on specific subject matter and customized to address specific needs) and Coaching, Mentoring and Consultation (individualized assistance in areas requested).

ONLINE JOB BOARD. CCSC participants have access to the GCU Online Job Board to post employment opportunities and search for applicants.

EVENT DISCOUNTS. CCSC participants will receive priority communication about events on GCU's campus, including discounted ticket opportunities.

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Grand Canyon University is regionally accredited by the Higher Learning Commission. (800-621-7440; <http://hlcommission.org/>) *CCSC Scholarship: This award is for students attending any private high school in any state that participates in GCU's CCSC program. This scholarship is renewable for the fall and spring semesters only, as long as you maintain the minimum GCU GPA required, attend the campus worship service of your choice weekly and meet the 20-hour community service requirement each semester. This scholarship is subject to the Grand Canyon University CAP policy and cannot exceed your charges. Grand Canyon University CAP Policy: GCU scholarships are allowed to be combined up to the following limits: Chancellor IB/President's Scholars in campus housing—up to \$16,500; all other scholars in campus housing—up to \$14,000; All scholars living off campus—up to \$11,500. Micro-scholarships, generated through organizations like raise.me, may not be combined with any other form of GCU-funded institutional aid or scholarships. Micro-scholarships may replace GCU institutional aid—up to \$6,000 per academic year. Please note that the monetary amount above does not include any other grants for which you may qualify. **This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any other GCU scholarships/awards. This scholarship will be applied toward your tuition only, and you will not receive funds in excess of your charges. GCU reserves the right to change scholarship and grant awards at any time without notice. ***Benefits available to governing board members would be subject to district and school policies.
