See GCU University Policy Handbook or speak to a GCU enrollment counselor for more details.</p> <p>o Students may transfer a maximum of 90 semester credit hours, no more than 84 credits of which can be lower-division.</p> <p>o Students must earn and/or transfer a minimum of 36 semester credits in upper division (300 or above) courses.</p> <p>o Students must earn and/or transfer a minimum of 120 semester credits in order to earn a Bachelor degree.</p> <p>o All Grand Canyon University programs follow a Program of Study, which can be changed by the University at any time.
