



Grand Canyon University's BSN Program in Englewood, Colorado will host an accreditation site visit by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) from **Feb. 11, 2026 to Feb. 13, 2026**. This site visit seeks initial CCNE accreditation for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program.

As required by CCNE, at least two months before the scheduled on-site evaluation, Grand Canyon University must notify its constituents, including, at a minimum, faculty teaching and students enrolled in the program that an accreditation review is scheduled.

CCNE will receive third-party comments no later than 21 days prior to the first day of the scheduled evaluation, which is Feb. 11, 2026.

In accordance with CCNE's procedures, the Commission provides the opportunity for program constituents and other interested parties to submit, in writing, third-party comments concerning a program's qualifications for accreditation. All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English, consistent with CCNE's policy on Conduct of Business in English.
