## Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) Connection's Purpose

Under GCU's Student Disability Services, the ASD Connection program offers individualized support — academically, socially and accommodations for ASD students.

## How We Aim to Support Neurodivergent Students

- **Academic support** in various academic workshops, time management, locating GCU resources and personalized, reserved tutoring sessions in math and writing.
- **Peer support in student clubs on campus**, where neurodivergent students are accompanied by student workers to initiate initial interactions with student clubs and organizations.
- **Social opportunities in smaller, less overwhelming settings**, such as game nights, various small group outings on campus and activities in student clubs.
- **One-on-one coaching sessions** that reinforce the support students receive and provide time to address individualized needs from a trained university representative. Each student can leave with a personalized plan for the upcoming class requirements, including tips, tricks and advice to help students overcome areas with which they may struggle.
