AGGREGATE VERIFICATION

Your application for financial aid was selected for review in a process called "Verification." Please submit the documentation as soon as possible but no later than 120 days after your last day of enrollment, or by September 2025, whichever occurs first. The exact deadline date is determined by the Department of Education (ED) and is typically announced by the end of June. No funds will be disbursed until the verification process is completed. Failure to complete the verification process by the deadline will result in your ineligibility for Title IV funds for the award year. The law states we have the right to ask you for this information before awarding any federal aid. If there are differences between the information supplied on your federal application and your financial documents, we will need to correct this information. We must review the required information under the financial aid program rules (34 CFR, Part 668). The Department of Education has requested that the institution verify certain items for a student selected for this review.

** Certain information requested within this form will not be necessary if you and/or your spouse were able to retrieve your tax information using the IRS Direct Data Exchange when completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA and no changes were made after the information was transferred.
